Site A: CO 67 - Cripple Creek to Divide

Traffic Impacts

Daylight Hours, Monday, Nov. 20 through Friday, Nov. 24

** Due to the Thanksgiving holiday, work is anticipated on Monday 11/20 and Tuesday 11/21 only.

Please Note: During the fall season when temperatures are below acceptable levels, there will be no mainline paving undertaken on that day.

Lane Restrictions - Travel reduced to one lane in both directions for Shouldering operations, and Guard rail operations.

- **Monday, Nov. 20**, Guard rail operations at MP 52.2 to 53, Northbound and Southbound. Shouldering operations, MP 55 to MP 63 both Northbound and Southbound.
- **Tuesday, Nov. 21**, Guard rail operations at MP 52.5 to 54, Northbound and Southbound. Shouldering operations, MP 57 to 67, both Northbound and Southbound.
- Measurements are approximate and will vary from day to day depending on production.
- Flaggers and pilot car present.
- Speed limit reductions in place.

- Flagger and pilot car present
- Speed limit reductions in place

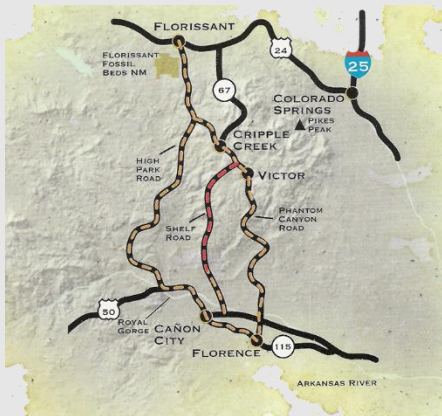
Additional Project Site Information:
