Site A: CO 67 - Cripple Creek to Divide

Traffic Impacts

Daylight Hours, Monday, Aug. 21 through Thursday, Aug. 24

Traffic Impacts: Travel lanes reduced to one lane in both direction for Cold In Place Recycling (CIPR) operations.

- Thursday, Aug. 24, MP 62.5 to 60.5 Southbound and Mile Post 58 to 56.5 Southbound
- Measurements are approximate and will vary from day to day depending on production.
- Flaggers and pilot car present.
- Speed limit reductions in place.

Additional Project Site Information:

- 12 foot wide load restriction during construction hours.
- Paving will begin roughly two weeks after the CIPR operation.



Site B: CO 67 - Woodland Park to Westcreek

Traffic Impacts

Daylight Hours, Monday, Aug. 21 through Friday, Aug. 25

Lane restrictions - Travel reduced to one lane in both directions for milling and paving operations.

- Tuesday, Aug. 22, MP 83 to 81.5 Southbound and Mile Post 91 to 92 Northbound
- Wednesday, Aug. 23, MP 81.5 to 80 Southbound
- Thursday, Aug. 24, MP 80 to 78.5 Southbound



- Friday, Aug. 25, MP 78.5 to 77.5 Southbound
- Measurements are approximate and will vary from day to day depending on production.
- Flaggers and pilot car present
- Speed limit reductions in place

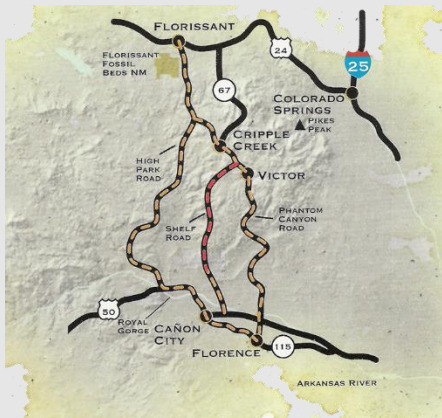
Additional Project Site Information:

- Bikers and pedestrians will be stopped by flaggers and instructed to follow construction rules of the road.
