Site A: CO 67 - Cripple Creek to Divide

Traffic Impacts

Daylight Hours, Monday, Aug. 28 through Thursday, Aug. 31

NOTE: The Fall Push begins. There will be TWO Cold In Place (CIPR) operations at TWO different areas this week.

Traffic Impacts: Travel lanes reduced to one lane in both direction for TWO Cold In Place Recycling (CIPR) operations.

- Measurements are approximate and will vary from day to day depending on production.
- Flaggers and pilot car present.
- Speed limit reductions in place.

Additional Project Site Information:

- 12 foot wide load restriction during construction hours.
- Paving will begin roughly two weeks after the CIPR operation.

- Speed limit reductions in place

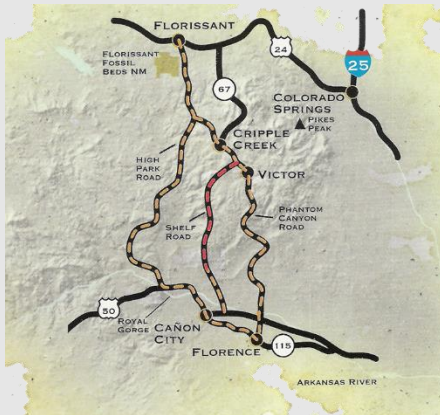
Additional Project Site Information:
