PUBLIC NOTICE OF REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes 1-7.5-107 (2.5) (a), notice is hereby given that the Regular Municipal Election for the City of Woodland Park will be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2020. This election is being conducted by mail ballot. Ballots will be mailed to all active registered voters between March 16 and March 19, 2020. Ballots may be returned by mail or in person to City Hall, 220 West South Avenue, Woodland Park, Colorado 80863, Monday through Friday 7:30AM to 5:00PM at any time prior to election day, on April 4, 2020 from 8:00 AM to noon. On Election Day, the polls will be open from 7:00AM to 7:00PM. The polling place is located in City Hall, 220 West South Avenue, Woodland Park, Colorado 80863. Electors may drop off their ballot at that location on Election Day from 7:00AM to 7:00PM. Requests for replacement ballots may be made at City Hall on Election Day from 7:00AM to 7:00PM. In addition, requests for absentee ballots may also be made at City Hall during normal business hours. Absentee ballots may be returned by mail or in person at City Hall prior to 7:00PM on Election Day in order to be counted. At this election, a Mayor shall be elected for a term of two (2) years, and three (3) Councilmembers shall be elected to four-year terms, and there are eleven (11) Charter Amendment questions.
